COURSE DESCRIPTION

Year Three Pre-requisite: Successful completion of Year One and Year Two Program

During the third-year internship program you will work with Christ Image Ministries gaining hands-on experience of the revivalist's role as well as being placed under the tutelage of the pastoral team at the Christ Image Church to obtain a working knowledge of day to day operations in a church and ministry setting.

CIBC Bachelor of Ministry (BOM) degree will deepen your understanding of the Bible and begin to equip you with practical skills for service which can be used in a variety of ministry contexts. Spending three years with CIBC will greatly increase opportunities for growth in discipleship as well as exposure to leadership opportunities in your pursuit to becoming a disciple maker. CIBC has an unquestionably solid foundation from which learners can pursue further educational opportunities, namely masters and Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.).
